## Joshua 24:15

"But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your forefathers served beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

### Discussion for the Younger Kids:

Has it ever seemed hard to be a Christian? Do kids at school pick on you for not joining them in being bad? Sometimes the life gets pretty rough and we think that it was better before we knew God. Many have felt that way, but God loves us and will always help us get through whatever it is.

### For Further Discussion:

In Joshua's final speech he is reminding the Israelites about all God has done for them. God delivered them from Egypt and gave them victories over all the armies who fought against them. He asks the Israelites if they would rather worship God or the idols of their forefathers. We can ask ourselves the same question today. Do we want to worship the idols of popularity, outward appearance, material possessions and success as defined by this world or will we worship the one true God? When you are tempted to worship other gods, think back over your life and remember all the times God was there for you just as he was for the Israelites. Has he not delivered you from your sins as you put your faith in Christ? What trials has he brought you through? Will you choose to serve the God who loves you and has walked by your side? Can you say like Joshua, I will serve the Lord?
