Isaiah 43:1-3

“Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I AM the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.”

Discussion for the younger kids:

This verse is important to me because it comforts me to know that my Savior God WILL be with me, even though I have to go through some pretty hard things at times. When we are afraid, the most important thing we want is to know that we are not alone; and God knew that and put this verse in just for those times. Ask your Mom or Dad or your Grandparents to tell you about a time that was really hard for them. Did they know God was there for them when they needed Him?

For Further Discussion:

This verse is important to me because it comforts me to know that my Savior God WILL be with me, even though I have to go through some pretty hard things at times. When we are afraid, the most important thing we want is to know that we are not alone; and God knew that, and put this verse in just for those times. It's comforting to know that God sees me and will be right next to me during those trials. Can you think of a time when you had to deal with something really difficult? Who was there for you? Sometimes God gives us peace and confidence straight from Him and sometimes He gives us friends and family to help us through the hard time. Either way, He is there for us – always!
