Assisted: Must have a minimum of one person assisting, and can have a maximum of 3 people assisting.  
May not cross into any other division.

## SHOW RULES

1. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place.
2. Rain Date is In the case of inclement weather, or for more information Call (717)896-3441 ext. 115
3. Camp Hebron Meadowview Stables, its staff, committee members, volunteers, sponsors, officials, etc. will not be responsible for any accident, death, injury, loss or theft which occurs at or during the show or on the grounds.
4. All entrants must sign a release before showing. Participants 17 & under must have a parent or guardian sign.
5. All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted anywhere on the show grounds.
6. Dress is not formal, but must be suitable and safe (i.e. long pants or breeches, riding boots or proper footwear) (no tank tops, sneakers, shorts are to be worn while riding.)
7. Ages are as of January 1st of current year.
8. Must show proof of rabies and current negative Coggins (within one year)
9. Class entries will be closed when previous class is called.
10. NO DOGS on show grounds!
11. Scratches for a refund must be done before the prior class has begun.
12. Management reserves the right to cancel, change, or combine classes.
13. Schooling will be permitted in the ring at designated times. No more than 12 horses will be permitted to school at a time.
14. Dangerous or unsportsmanlike conduct in the ring, during breaks, during classes or on the grounds is cause for dismissal from the class or show at the discretion of the judge and/or show management.
15. The judge's decision is final.
