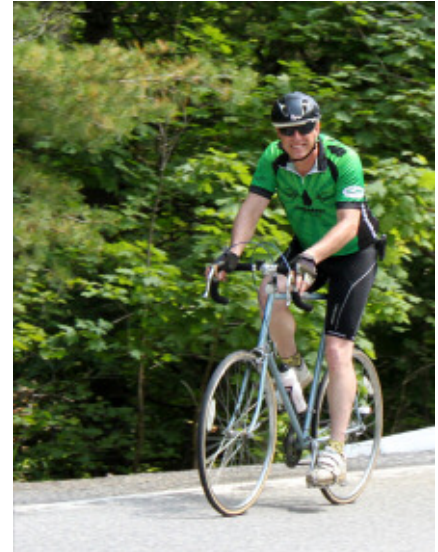

Memorial Day Weekend Road Biking Fund Raiser!

May 26-27, 2012

Camp Hebron is excited to continue this new program and fund raiser after a stellar event last year! This year we will be doing 2 different single day rides. The Saturday ride will be a laid back **50 miles** enjoying great scenery as you wind your way along the base of the mountains. Sunday's ride will be a fun and scenic **100 mile** loop exploring the valleys around Camp Hebron and ending at a favorite Camp Hebron hang out spot, 3B's ice cream shop! Each day's ride will be fully supported with food and encouragement roughly every 10 miles and there will be a bike mechanic along in a support vehicle to help with any repairs or other needs that may arise along the ride.

Participants from both rides are invited to stay at Camp Hebron Saturday night for food, fun, and fellowship at no additional cost. Family members are also welcome to join for only the cost of meals. Included in your ride package are a fully supported ride, dinner and lodging on Saturday night, and breakfast on Sunday morning.



Saturday, riders for the Camp Hebron 50 should plan to arrive at Camp Hebron around 10:00 a.m. to check in and load your bike onto the bike rack. We will depart from Camp Hebron at 10:30 a.m. and start the Camp Hebron 50 mile ride at 12:00 p.m. from Kenbrook Bible Camp. From there riders will enjoy the scenic countryside along the base of Blue Mountain ending up at 3B's Ice Cream shop. A van will be there to take you and your bike back over to Camp Hebron. (Due to limited parking available at Kenbrook riders are asked to park personal cars at Camp Hebron. There will be limited transportation available back to the starting point for those interested but this is by request only and we must know in advance of the weekend).

Sunday we will start the Camp Hebron 100 from in front of the Hemlock Center at Camp Hebron at 8:30 a.m. Riders not staying overnight on Saturday should plan to check in before 8:00 a.m. From Camp Hebron you will get to explore the amazing countryside in and around Camp Hebron as you wind your way thru beautiful valleys, alongside babbling brooks, and sneaking between mountains to a finish on one of Central PA's best bike rides down Clarks Valley Road. The ride will end at 3B's Ice Cream Shop where you can regain some energy before taking the short van ride back over to Camp Hebron!

The donations and proceeds from this ride will go to benefit the ministry at Camp Hebron. Specifically this year we will be using the money raised by our riders to revamp popular recreation options, such as the tennis courts and pool area. We've wanted to resurface the tennis courts for a while now to keep them in good shape for those who love to play the game. This court resurfacing alone may cost over \$10,000. We are hoping to raise funds for this project in order to keep fees for rental groups and summer camp as low as possible. To that end we are asking riders to raise a minimum contribution of \$200 in order to participate in this fun event.

Upon registration we'll ask for a \$50 deposit and from there we'll send you a **welcome packet** with more ride details but also some materials that can help you raise support for this ride. As people give to this project in your name we'll count their donations towards your remaining \$150 participation donation. **Bikers raising at least \$300 in support will receive a custom bike jersey designed specifically for this ride!** Again all the money raised from this event goes to support the ministry at Camp Hebron. Riders wanting to take part in both the Camp Hebron 50 and the Camp Hebron 100 may certainly do so and would only need to raise a minimum of \$300 to take part in both days or raise at least \$400 to receive the bike jersey. By using the support packet sent you and raising money to help the ministry of Camp Hebron you can enjoy this whole weekend only paying \$50 out of pocket and get a sweet bike jersey to boot!!
