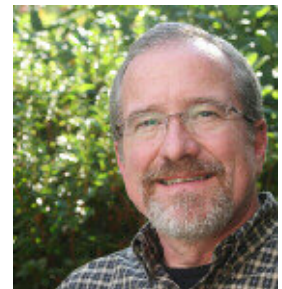

Dear Youth Leaders,

We would like to invite you and your youth group (grades 9-12) to join us at Camp Hebron for our **Senior High Retreat** held **February 3-5, 2012**. We hope to pack the house for one great weekend full of spiritual growth and fun. The retreat fee is \$97 per person and includes 3 large group sessions, youth group breakout discussions, 2 nights lodging, 5 meals (Saturday breakfast - Sunday lunch), 2 snacks and all the fun you can handle. For every 10 youth you register, one youth leader is free. If your group consists of guys and girls, both a male and female leader must accompany the group. The retreat is an exciting opportunity for all to deepen your relationship with God, develop friendships with each other and have a memorable time together. The beauty of this weekend is that Camp Hebron staff plans, provides and runs all the activities, meals and programming so that youth leaders can focus solely on building relationships with their youth. Leaders are expected to take primary responsibility for their group, which means staying in lodging with and supervising the youth closely, getting the group to activities on time and leading small group discussions which follow each of the main sessions.

Leading the three main large group sessions will be **George Davis**. George is someone who likes to lead others to experience God in fresh new ways. His practical insights, openness to discuss anything, and ability to connect with people will stretch your thinking and help you gain insight into yourself and your relationship with God. As a youth worker, construction contractor, pastor, student, husband, father, missions leader & iPod touch repair guy, George has lots of experience just doing life. His goal for this retreat will be to share some of the secrets he's found for living a real life, experiencing the Father's love, and following in the footsteps of the best person who ever lived (Jesus, not George). Worship in song each session will be led by **Tyler Margeson**, and friends from Harrisburg, PA, a talented group of musicians whose hearts are united in leading people before or great Savior in reverent and joyful worship. They have a passion to see the Lord move in hearts and lead with expectancy, worshipping in spirit and truth. This key component of the weekend will help us each connect with our Awesome Savior.



Registration Process

- Print off the [Registration form](#) from our website or request it via email as an attachment
- Gather *everyone's* (including leaders) name, address and date of birth on the Roster
- Mail in a copy of your registration (has roster on back) with check or money order
- Write one check payable to 'Camp Hebron' with 'Sr. High Retreat' on the memo line
- Print the [Waiver Form](#) double-sided, get parent signatures and *bring with you to camp*

We will take registrations on a first come first serve basis until our lodging is full. Due to space constraints, we cannot offer family housing and ask that you please find alternate care for younger children for the weekend. Lodging will be in our 12 cabins that sleep 11 each and Fern Glade cottage that can house up to 32. The cabins each have a bathroom and shower and Fern Glade has semi-private bathrooms. All units are set up with sturdy wooden bunk beds. Each participant will need to bring bedding, towels and personal toiletries. To maximize space it is likely that your group may share lodging space with another youth group (separated by gender of course).

We can accept credit card payment by phone or online but need a copy of the roster form (mail in or fax). Registrations will not be processed unless all information and payment is provided and complete.

Registration fees are non-refundable except for sudden illness or bereavement but are transferable to another group member. Any registrations postmarked within the two weeks leading up to the retreat will be an extra \$10/person. The closer we get to February you may want to call first to check availability or before adding youth to your roster. If you have any questions regarding the retreat I welcome a call or email.
